

# Kenton County Republican Women's Club Mary Middleton Scholarship Program Guidelines

## **General Information:**

The Mary Middleton Scholarship is presented annually to a student who understands the importance of civic engagement within the young adult community. The \$500 scholarship is named in honor of KCRWC's founder, Mary Middleton, who dedicated over fifty years of service to the organization. A tireless volunteer, Mary devoted significant personal energies to public and community service.

## **Qualifications:**

Applicants must be residents of Kenton County attending a Kenton County High School or be home schooled. The applicant must begin his or her post-secondary education at an accredited school for either a two year or four year degree in the summer or fall of 2012.

## **Administration:**

The Mary Middleton Scholarship program is administered under the supervision of the KCRWC Scholarship Committee. The committee is responsible for the implementation of the program, including the recruitment of applicants and the selection of the Scholarship Award winner.

## **Application:**

1. Complete a copy of the enclosed application form.
2. Submit one letter of reference.
3. Submit a 400-600 word essay discussing the importance of a young adult being involved with the Republican Party.
4. Sign the application form.
5. Send the essay, application form and letter of reference to:
