Jamie, a native of Tompkinsville, was elected AgComm on November 8, 2011. His passion for agriculture is reflected in his vast amount of experience in the areas of agriculture and business. He is the founder and owner of James Comer, Jr. Farms, a 950-acre beef cattle, timber and hay farming operation located in Monroe County. He also co-owns Comer Land & Cattle Co., a family farming operation which includes his father and brother. He was a director of South Central Bank for 12 years and was the 1999-2000 Monroe County Chamber of Commerce President. Jamie is a Western Kentucky University graduate with a degree in Agriculture. In 2000, he was elected to the Kentucky House of Representatives at just 27 years old, and hit the ground running, passing a record of five bills into law-the most for a freshman member of the "R" caucus in Frankfort. Jamie is married to Tamara Jo (T.J.) and they have three children: Reagan, Harlan and Aniston. We look forward to having Jamie join us to explain his role as Commissioner of Agriculture!


Reservations must be made no later than noon on Wednesday, Oct. 22nd.
