# Join us and special guest speaker State Rep. David Floyd!

We'll begin with **registration at 11:30 a.m.** and the **luncheon/program** beginning at Noon at the **Oriental Wok** on Buttermilk Pike in Ft. Mitchell.

Rep. David Floyd represents the 50th legislative district in the Kentucky General Assembly. He is serving his sixth term and is from Nelson County, and he will be discussing the conservative case against the death penalty. Floyd holds a Bachelor of Science degree from the U.S. Air Force Academy and a Master's degree from Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University. He was a United States Air Force command pilot, flying the Lockheed U-2 and the Boeing KC-135. He served as wing operations officer in Operation Desert Storm and commanded a squadron of 100 aviators. His combat service earned him the Bronze Star and the Distinguished Unit Citation with Valor Device. Floyd is a life member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW) and the American Legion.

Following his military career he was president of his family business in senior care, operating continuing care retirement communities. He served on the Board of Directors of his local Air Board and Chamber of Commerce, and is a member of the Nelson County Economic Development Agency. He's past president of the Bardstown Optimist Club. He served his church as moderator, deacon and Sunday school teacher.

Floyd, 64, and his wife Cheri live in Bardstown, and have two adult children.
