**PRESIDENT PAM DIMMERMAN SAYS...** While reading the book entitled *"In the Words of Ronald Reagan"*, written by his son, Michael, I couldn't help but wonder what President Reagan would have to say about the upcoming presidential election. I certainly hear what others are saying about it as most of you probably do. There seems to be such division among the two major parties in this country but, is it really division? Or, do we choose to let others tell us there is a division?

According to Michael's accounts of his father's political activities, President Reagan actively campaigned for Democratic candidates for much of the 1950's. It wasn't until he was giving speeches about the decline of America that he realized, "he was supporting and voting for the very people who were contributing to that decline." It is my understanding this notation was written long before President Reagan would become the head of the free world. I cannot speak for everyone but I believe, our country as it is today, is much like the America Michael describes in his book. We are a nation badly needing to be healed; morally, spiritually, economically and militarily. We are a nation of people who need to humble ourselves and turn away from our wicked ways.

We need to pray for God's Mercy and ask for forgiveness and healing. We need to return to our values and principles in order to "Make America Great Again". God Bless you, each and every one.
