Meeting reminders:



Did you know it was the first Kentucky General Assembly that adopted the official seal of the Commonwealth, includ-



ing the state motto, "United We Stand, Divided We Fall", on December 20, 1792? I didn't.

It went on to say that Patrick Henry used the phrase in his last public speech, given in March 1799, in which he denounced *The Kentucky and Virginia Resolutions*. Clasping his hands and swaying unsteadily, Henry declared, "Let us trust God, and our better judgment to set us right hereafter. United we stand, divided we fall. Let us not split into factions which must destroy that union upon which our existence hangs."

My hope and my prayer these last weeks and the upcoming weeks leading to the November election, is that as conservatives we stand united, we vote and we pray for God's Will as the votes are counted and the winner announced. I never want my grandchildren to live at the expense of my choice to stay home and do nothing in one of the most important elections in my lifetime. What will you do?
