From Ruth Korzenborn ~ AMERICAN FLAG NOTES - VI

Since this year 2018 there will be all county elected officials running for office. We will be in parades and many ceremonies.

- The flag, when carried in a procession or with another flag or flags, should be either on the marching right; that is, the flag's own right or if there is a line of other flags, in front of the center of that line.
- The flag should not be displayed on a float in a parade except from a staff (or as against a wall or in a window).
- The flag should form a distinctive feature of the ceremony of unveiling a statue or monument. But it should never be used as the covering for the statue or monument.
- That no disrespect should be shown to the flag of the United States of America, the flag should be dipped to any person or thing. Regimental colors, State flags and organization or institutional flags are to be dipped as a mark of honor.
- The flag should never be carried flat or horizontally, but always aloft and free.
- During the ceremony of hoisting or lowering the flag or when the flag is passing in a parade or in review, all persons present except those in uniform should face the flag and stand at attention with the right hand over the heart. Those present in uniform should render the military salute. When not in uniform men should remove their hat with their right hand and hold it at the left shoulder, the hand being over the heart. Aliens should stand at attention. The salute to the flag in a moving column should be rendered at the monument the flag passes.
- The flag should not be draped over the hood, top, sides, or back of a vehicle or a railroad train or boat. When the flag is displayed on a motorcar, the staff shall be fixed firmly to the chassis or clamped to the right fender.
