This month we will be having a panel to speak on the important topic of the opioid crisis in Northern Kentucky. Commonwealth Attorney Rob Sanders will speak to us about law enforcement issues with facts and figures so we can get an idea of the scope of the problem. Judge Patricia Summe will then speak about how the judicial system handles drug offenders and how this has changed. Finally, Jim Beiting, Executive Director of Transitions will speak about what types of treatment are available to people with drug problems and the challenges he faces in that realm. There is sure to be some interesting discussion between these three people and Sheriff Korzenborn will also share his insights on this horrible problem plaguing our community.

Cost for the meeting is \$18.00 and may be paid for with cash or check upon arrival. 
