

While many have access to modern day communications, like Skype and email, having hand-written notes of encouragement or appreciation can really help bolster spirits of our beloved military heroes, letting them know that they are not alone during the winter holiday season. If you're interested in sending cards to our soldiers deployed overseas, please bring them to our monthly meetings (September – November).

Please follow these guidelines to assure that all cards are acceptable:

- Please send the card only - no envelopes, keep the envelopes for your personal use.
- If you are making cards, please keep the size to no larger than an 8 x 11 size paper folded in half. DO NOT use glitter or any other product that could come loose when we open the box or envelope. The USASOA office is within walking distance to the United States Capitol and security is of paramount importance these days.
- Address the card to "Dear Soldier, Dear Warrior or Dear Hero" etc. Be respectful and polite.
- Write a holiday greeting, keeping in mind that our Troops are diverse in their holiday practices and beliefs.
- Write a personal note. For example: How do you celebrate the holidays? What are your family memories of holidays?
- Sign your first name ONLY and the town and state where you live.
- Be sure to include you are a member of the KCRWC. If you are a veteran or an elected official, please consider including that information in your card.
