



Join us for our meeting on May 20, 2024 with registration beginning at 11:30am and the program at noon!







In a primary, remember that not every race is on the ballot, just the ones with same party opponents. For 2024, there is a Democratic ballot, a Republican ballot and a Non-Partisan ballot for the City of Covington. If your party affiliation is other than Democrat or Republican, there isn't a ballot available in the primary. But if you live in the City of Covington, you will have a non-partisan ballot. For the General Election, all registered voters will have a ballot and you can vote for any candidate of your choosing.

BY MAIL - ABSENTEE BALLOT (EXCUSE REQUIRED)

Mail-in absentee ballot requests can be made online at <u>www.govote.ky.gov</u> or call (859) 392-1620. Absentee portal is open from April 6 to May 7

Drop boxes for absentee ballots are available at the Kenton County Government Center (1840 Simon Kenton Way in Covington) or the Historic Kenton County Courthouse (5272 Madison Pike in Independence).



IN-PERSON ABSENTEE (EXCUSE REQUIRED)

In-person absentee voting will be available at the Kenton County Government Center (1840 Simon Kenton Way in Covington) on May 8, May 9, May 10 May 13, May 14 & May 15 from 7:30 AM - 4 PM



EARLY IN-PERSON (NO EXCUSE REQUIRED)

Early voting centers will be available on May 16, May 17 & May 18 from 7:30 AM to 4:00 PM. Early voting centers allow you to go to any available location. Available locations are online at <u>www.kentoncountykyclerk.com</u> under Where to Vote.
