VOTING INFORMATION:

For those needing an Absentee Ballot, the portal will be open from September 21st through October 22nd.

Go to: https://vrsws.sos.ky.gov/abrweb/beginning 9/21 to request via the portal.

There are three ways for Kentucky voters to cast their ballot for the 2024 GENERAL Election:

- 1) Excused In-person Absentee Voting before Election Day, October 23, 24, 25 and October 28, 29, 30, 2024.
- 2) În-person No Excuse Absentee Voting before Election Day, October 31st November 2nd, 2024.
- 3) In-person on Election Day, November 5th, 2024.

Amendment 1 is a citizenship requirement measure. Voters get a choice of a "Yes" or "No" vote. If voters approve the amendment/vote "yes": Kentucky's constitution will change to say, "no person who is not a citizen of the United States shall be allowed to vote" in Kentucky elections.
