for our first meeting of 2026!


Our speakers will be Spike Jones, KC Police Chief and Marc Fields, KC Jailer.


## By Laws Bits...

### Meet Your President – Pam Roberts Albers

Pam retired as Director of Constituent Services with 21 years on staff of US Senator Jim Bunning. She served 12 years in the US House and 9 years in the US Senate.

Pam served the KCRWC as President in 2016 and 2017 after several other positions in the club. She presided over the Kentucky Federation of Republican Women as State President from January 1, 2021, through December 31, 2022.

In 2024 she was appointed by immediate Past President of the National Federation of Republican Women to serve on the Subcommittee to Keep 9 Justices on the US Supreme Court with her committee appointment ending on December 31, 2025. Pam recently accepted a new appointment by the current National President to chair the national Committee to Keep 9 Justices on SCOTUS.

She has been involved in her community and is a founding member of the Aldersgate Apartments in Florence, Kentucky and the Fisher House at the VA Medical Center in Cincinnati, Ohio. Pam currently serves as Campaign Manager for State Representative Kim Moser and has worked on many campaigns throughout her 35+ year career to elect Republicans to office.

She married her high school sweetheart, Dan in 2025, resides in Crestview Hills, is the mother of two daughters and grandmother to their 5 children. She and Dan attend Faith Community Church on Richardson Road in Independence, Kentucky.
